




6.1. After you have completed your transfer from Stock—> Quality control, you will then need to Scrap the product. From your internal transfer, select 'Scrap' from the top left hand corner.








6.2. After you select 'Scrap' a window will popup like below.



- 6.3. From here, you will need to fill out the following:
 - 6.3.1. Product
 - 6.3.2. Quantity
 - 6.3.3. Package (Lot#)
 - 6.3.4. Source Location (This should be Depot/Quality Control)
 - 6.3.5. Scrap Location (Virtual Location/Depot)






- 6.4. Once you've confirmed the information, select 'Done'
- 6.5. Once you've finished, you will still need to validate the scrap. Now go back to the inventory module:




6.6. At the top, go to 'Operations' and select 'Scrap'



6.7. Now select the scrap that you created from the menu:



6.8. Once you've opened the scrap,select 'Validate'. After, you should see a log note that says that the status has moved from Draft—>Done. If you see this, you've successfully scrapped a product.
